4. The **Virginia American Legion Exhibit Hall** houses the Howard P. and Jean H. Hart Collection of U.S. Martial Arms and artifacts. Combined

with changing exhibits and focus items, from the American Revolution to today, it stands as a tribute to the resolve, spirit and skills of Virginians who have fought to gain and preserve our Nation's freedom.

10 & 11. The **Commonwealth's Memorial** to those Virginians who made the ultimate sacrifice beginning with World War II through the present day.



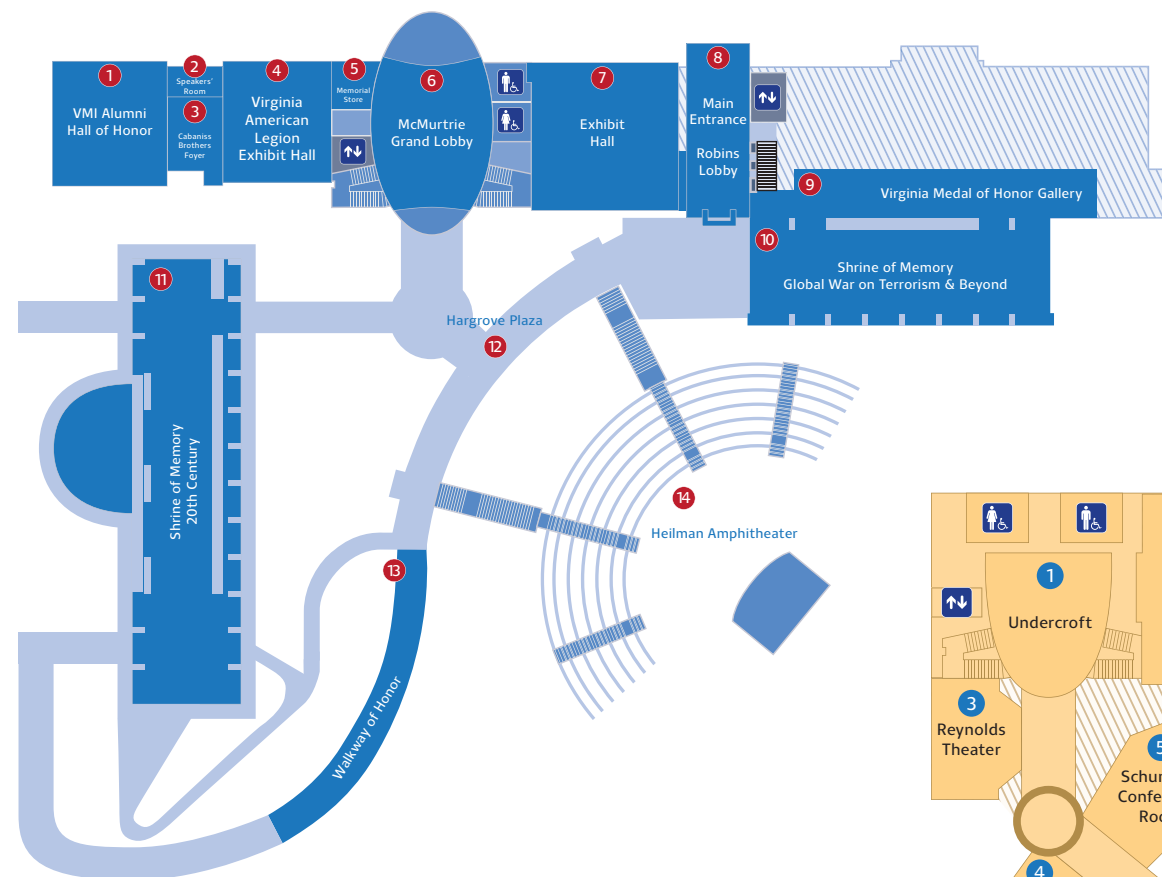
3. The **Reynolds Theater** features our award-winning series of video programs, tracing the path of Virginians as they fought to preserve a free America.

These documentaries record the memories and experiences of Virginians who were there – recorded in their own words.

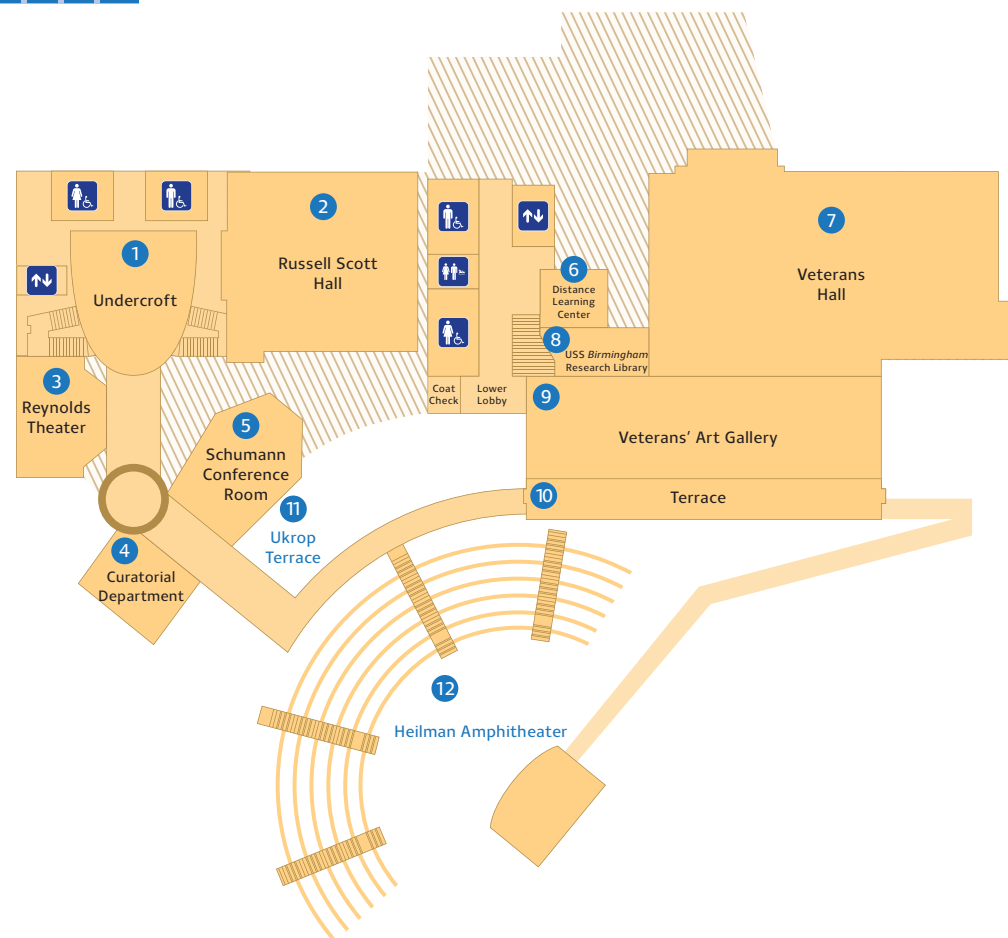
